In the light of our order dated 16.01.2015, report has been received from 36 out of 87 registered Gaushala. Let report from the remaining Gaushala be also received and produced before us in the week commencing 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2015.

Put up this matter on 02.02.2015 under the same heading maintaining its position. In the meanwhile, steps to remove the encroachments from Gaushala land from which report has already been received, be taken particularly in those cases in which there is no judicial or quasi judicial stay orders.

In the cases in which stay orders are there, steps be taken to get the stay vacated within a reasonable time, in any case within one month from today. Within the same time, steps be taken for getting the other Gaushala lands free of encroachment.
